Working with delicate shades of purple and green and adding delicate beads on 32ct linen, you will create this wonderful collection of floral inspired needlework accessories. The tiny beaded treasures will include a needle book with a silk pocket, a scissor sheath, tufted pincushion, pin keep, thimble silk pouch and tape measure. In class you will learn how to make the pieces and the functional ort/carryall basket by manipulating the silk taffeta and lining a 4" Nantucket basket. Class time will focus on finishing steps and techniques stitching with beads, preparing the linen for finishing steps, attaching silk to linen, joining, attaching and making hedebo loops, cording, bows, buttons, stuffing and shaping.

Kit includes: written instructions, graph, photos, finishing kit (all supplies needed to stitch and finish — hand dyed silk fibers, linen, beads, templates, mat board, batting ribbon and basket.





Fawn" along with Olde Willow Stitchery's floss will be used to reproduce this sampler. Notice the intricate bands, motifs and sawtooth borders Sally chose for her work of needle art. Join Robin to hear all about Sally and her sampler, and take home a piece of New England history for your personal collection. The original sampler will be in a future article of Piecework with a few motifs used on a shirt, and information on the Old Sturbridge Museum Collection

Kit includes: Chart, color photo, transfer for embroidery, transfer pen, linen, full skeins of floss and needle.

Canvas Notebook 2 - Beyond the Basics

If herringbone mystifies you, if eyelets frustrate you, and if Sprat's head puzzles you, this is the class for you! We will work on easy to see 18 ct. Canvas and compile stitches for a reference notebook, with fronts and backs of stitches easily visible. We'll take basic herringbone, then expand it to double herringbone, 6 trip herringbone, herringbone squares and leaves, and then interlace it. Learn the secrets of a prefect eyelet, worked as individual stitches and in rows, then shaped as squares, diamonds, hearts, and triangles. Sprat's heads will pose no problem after this class, with triangles, hearts and even round Sprat's. Explore how the stitches look worked with #5 and #8 pearl cotton, #4 and #8 metallic braid, cotton floss and over-dyed heavy cotton. This class is prefect for a good start to compiling a notebook for reference later.

Kit includes: Stretcher bars, tacks, canvas, DMC floss, metallic #4 and #8, pearl cottons #5 and #8. Please bring to class a laying tool in addition to usual stitching supplies.

Carefully Inwrought: Nantucket Samplers: Located thirty miles off the coast of Massachusetts, Nantucket, the "Faraway Isle," was far from isolated during the 1700s and early 1800s. The island's whaling trade provided a cosmopolitan flair as goods from all over the world passed through its port. Not surprisingly, island samplers show several different sets of motifs and styles. Aimee E. Newell, former Curator of Collections at the Nantucket Historical Association, will present an illustrated lecture on the history of Nantucket samplers. Learn to identify the "Nantucket tree," and enjoy the stories of Quaker girls who grew up to be sea captain's wives.

My Stitching Accessories interior has a central silk drawstring caddy that holds and stores the 3" bird's-eye maple layout tool and thread stick. A removable 30ct Dower stitched and tufted pincushion attaches neatly to one side, a needle page and scissor storage section on the opposite side. The outer case is stitched on 30ct Dower linen using a tent stitch with hand dyed fibers and AVS 100/3 and Bijoux fibers and it ties to store all your treasured supplies and tools. This burgundy colored case is held by the twisted cord hanger. The focus of class time will be on finishing techniques and steps — preparing the linen and silk, making twisted cord, attaching twisted cord, bow making and attaching buttons and rings.

Kit includes: Written instructions, graph, diagram, photos, complete stitching and finishing kit (hand dyed silk fibers, AVS 100/3 Bijoux fiber, 30ct Dower linen, antique needle page linen, templates, Mylar, Skirtex, pins, needles, hand dyed ribbons, mother of pearl buttons and ring, bird's eye maple 3" tool). Thread stick and initials graph will be optional to order.

Primitive artist Elsie Di Cassio has created a charming container to depict early life in New England. Using exceptionally coordinated autumn-toned over dyed silk fibers and silk fabrics, Marcia has fashioned a luxurious interior for the box making it an elegant stitcher's companion. The box features a divided tray for scissor and needle storage with bargello elements and silk lining, as well as a larger storage section embellished with stitched linen edging and a prominent monogram. Each student will be assisted in creating their own monogram in class. A verse offering an ode to the stitching artist graces the final section with a silk passementerie embellishment. Hidden beneath the tray is a fully lined green silk interior with a tufted bottom that cradles a lovely turned wood covered container with pin cushion top and a colonial motif. Antique white 28ct Cashel linen is chosen for the ground and is covered with cross stitch, cloud filling stitch, bargello patterns, back stitch and satin stitch. Thread Gatherer's Silk n' Colors, Gloriana silks and Gumnuts silk from Australia are used to create an extraordinary object d'art that is both elegant and useful. You will finish a good deal of the box in class with careful instruction and demonstrations by Marcia.

Kit includes: Hand-painted round sewing box with tray, linen, linen ribbon, silk fibers, overdyed fine ribbon trims, wooden pincushion, finishing materials containing silk fabrics, graphics, color photocopy and color photos in the text. Please bring light and magnification if needed.

In class you will discuss how to stitch and create this tiny rule and the focus will be on finishing techniques and steps to prepare the linen and silk, add structure and join silk to linen and linen to silk.

Kit includes: Written instructions, graph, diagram, photos, and complete stitching and finishing supplies (linens, silk fabric, templates, mat board, ribbon and the metal gauge).

Surrounding the hive is an octagonal green vine complete with flowers stitched in double running. Surrounding the center is a saying "How duth the tiny busy bee" stitched in an over-dyed fall foliage silk. The edge is worked in Nun Stitch with the spine stitched in Stepped Herringbone. A second bee hive is worked on the back for personalization.

To commemorate these women the Nantucket Petticoat Row is created on 32ct antique white Belfast linen using the finest silks and over-dyes from Gloriana and Thread Gatherer to represent the cobblestone Main Street, the gay storefronts, the busy docks, the bustling chandlery and the local provisioner. The elevated docks make one feel as though the tides are lapping at the pilings waiting for the next ship's arrival. The classic Main Street landmark, the Abiah Folger Franklin fountain, which is festooned with flowers all summer is depicted by a lovely hand turned wood piece embellished with a riot of stitched flowers. Two ships wait to off load their cargo of oil barrels and reprovision for their next trip to sea. The many textures of this project require a broad variety of stitches such as Scotch, the wave stitch, gobelin, cross and satin and more. Widow's walks atop the busy storefront buildings with their cascading flower boxes allow the waiting mistresses to gaze out to sea anticipating the arrival of their seamen. These elements are presented in a handsome 8" x 8" Nantucket basket. All stitching and finishing steps will be demonstrated and applied in class. Bring craft scissors.



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
